The first few months of the pandemic were a major shock to everyone. Everyone was dealing with the shock differently. As a single mother left with running the entire household, worrying about the financial situation and homeschooling my children, I found the new reality challenging, but in any situation there are opportunities. As universities had to adjust to the new reality and practically all courses were taken online I decided to take my chance and enrolled into a 3 semester degree course in September 2020 (Honours Bachelor in Management in Business in MTU) adding another one (Level 8 Certificate in Digital Marketing also in MTU). I am self-employed as a photographer and since the pandemic and lockdowns limited my work opportunities I used that time to take part in many business courses including multiple Local Enterprise Office courses (Video Marketing, Instagram Advertising etc.), the 8-week Women's Rural Entrepreneurship Network aka WREN programme (delivered by Ballyhoura Development), Stress Management course and NLP course.

I firmly believes in a balance between mental and physical activity I also took on an apprenticeship in the Bike Circus (community run bicycle workshop in Clonakilty) and after completing over 100 hours of work I finally graduated as a bicycle mechanic. I am still an active volunteer in the workshop and currently I am also a member of the Board of Trustees in the Bike Circus.

I can proudly say that in January 2022 I got awarded an Honours Bachelor Degree in Management in Business with the Second Class Honours Grade 1 result, took a role in a committee in Network Ireland West Cork responsible for social media, grew my photography business and had an honour to start working with many renowned businesses and organisations in Ireland.
